ON [REDACTED], SA DEREK PARKER AND FORMER SA SLOANE BURBANK INTERVIEWED CHARLES HIRSCH, M.D., CHIEF NEW YORK CITY MEDICAL EXAMINER. THE FOLLOWING AUTOPSY RESULTS WERE REVEALED. THE VICTIM HAD BEEN DRUGGED USING KETAMINE AND WAS UNABLE TO MOVE AS SHE WAS REPEATEDLY SLASHED AND STABBED WITH A LARGE KNIFE UNTIL A FATAL WOUND SEVERED HER AORTA. THE ATTACKER'S SKIN WAS FOUND UNDERNEATH THE VICTIM'S FINGERNAILS, AN INDICATION OF HER FAILED ATTEMPT TO FIGHT BACK PRIOR TO THE KETAMINE TAKING EFFECT. THE VICTIM APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN SEXUALLY ASSAULTED. DNA RESULTS DID NOT MATCH ANY OFFENDERS IN CODIS, BUT MATCHED OPEN CASES IN THE FORENSIC INDEX - ONE ONGOING NYPD INVESTIGATION, THE OTHER, AN ONGOING INVESTIGATION BY THE LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT IN [REDACTED], NJ.

ON [REDACTED], A WITNESS INTERVIEW WAS CONDUCTED WITH [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED], RESIDING AT [REDACTED]. ALSO PRESENT WERE FORMER SA SLOANE BURBANK AND SERGEANT BOB ERWIN, NYPD, MIDTOWN NORTH. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] BEING HELD AT KNIFEPOINT BY HER ATTACKER. SHE DESCRIBED THE KNIFE AS BIG, INTIMIDATING WITH A STEEL BLADE AT LEAST 6 INCHES LONG AND A COUPLE INCHES WIDE. IT WAS CURVED AT THE TOP, WITH A DARK, RIDGED HANDLE.
